
Online Book Club

Bring It To Life!

- 1. Have a Mexican food fiesta! Ask book club members and their parents to prepare a Mexican dish to share. Can't you just taste the enchiladas, fajitas, tacos, salsa, guacamole, and chimichangas? The possibilities are endless—and delicious!
- 2. Research the floor plan of the Alamo mission. Draw the floor plan on a poster board. Label each room with a different color. How many rooms were there? Do you think it was pretty crowded with 200 soldiers living there?
- 3. Are you clueless—or not? After everyone has finished reading the book, divide the book club into two teams. Direct each team to recall as many clues as they can from the book. List each clue, and then write down how each clue makes sense now that everyone knows the end of the story! The team with the most clues is the winner!
- 4. Create a crossword puzzle! Ask for a volunteer who is willing to create a crossword puzzle using the Spanish glossary words in the book. Pass out the crossword to book club members, and see who finishes (with all the words correct) first!
