

Bring It To Life!

- 1. Camp out like the mystery characters! Divide into two teams. Team One's assignment is to list all the things they would need to take if they were going camping. Team Two's assignment is to plan the meals and activities for a three-day camping trip on the coast of North Carolina!

- 4. Make up a story! Choose ten nouns, ten verbs, ten adjectives, and ten adverbs from the mystery book. Write them on the board. Assemble book club members in a circle. Go around the circle and make up a story about Grant and Christina by using the chosen words. Each member uses the next word on the list in a sentence to keep the story
