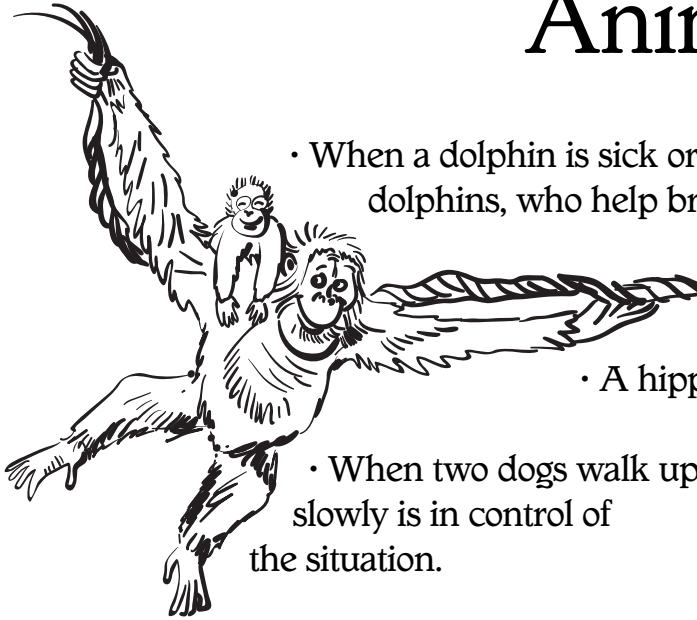


Animal Trivia

- Cats don't usually meow at each other. They meow to communicate with humans.

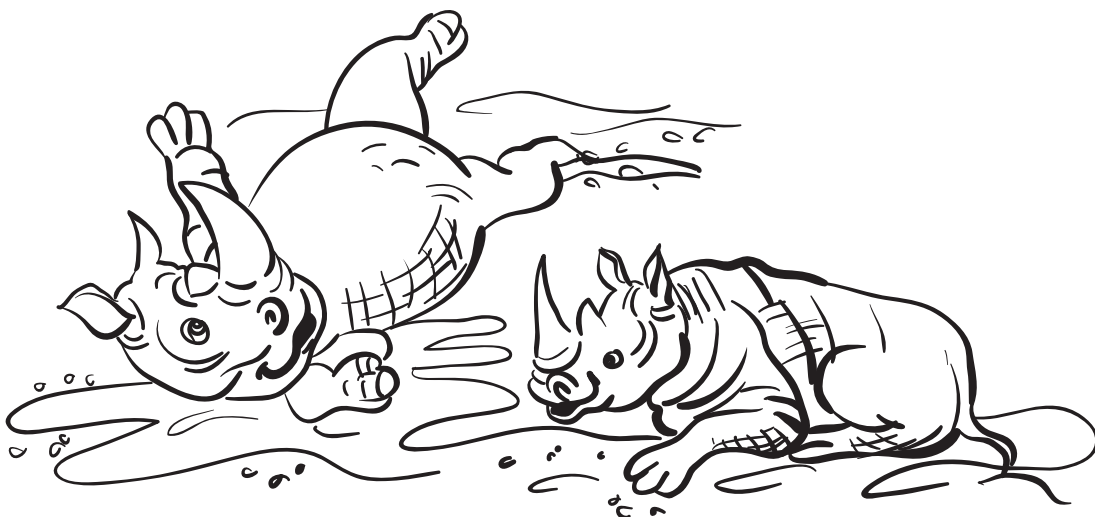
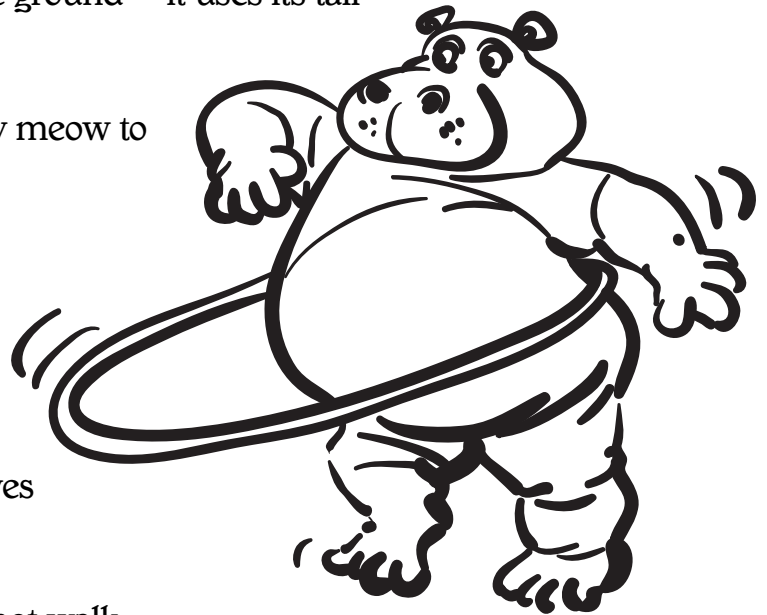
- What is a group of owls called?
