We Have Rights

The Declaration of Independence lists **natural rights** that belong to every human being. They are the right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.

"We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness."
—Declaration of Independence, 1776

These natural rights are part of us! They are "unalienable," which means they are part of our nature.

Right to Life—Every person has his own unique life. Every person has the right to live.
Right to Liberty—Every person has the right to be free.
Right to the Pursuit of Happiness—Every person has the right to seek happiness in life. Human beings naturally try to be happy! When people are controlled by someone else, that natural right is in danger!

Assess Your Understanding

Key philosophies in the Declaration of Independence were based on ideas expressed previously by European philosophers. As you read the secondary source information below, see if you can find the key philosophies found in the Declaration of Independence. Highlight or underline them.

In the late 1600s, an English philosopher by the name of John Locke wrote a book called *Two Treatises of Government*. He wrote that people have natural rights that cannot be taken away. To Locke, these included the right to life, liberty, and property.

Locke also expressed the idea that government is created to protect the rights of people. Government has only the powers the people agree to give it. If the government cannot protect the citizens' rights, the citizens have the right to choose new leaders who will do the job they are supposed to do.

The U.S. Constitution

The U.S. Constitution is the written plan for the U.S. government. Our constitution establishes the framework of our government. It describes how our government is organized. It describes what our government may and may not do. It gives certain powers to the government, and limits government power too. It separates government powers into different parts of the government. Especially important, the U.S. Constitution establishes our government as a democratic government. As a democracy, the ultimate power of the government is given to the people.

How democracy works in the United States:

- people are the source of government authority
- citizens vote to decide issues and choose representatives
- the government's powers are limited by the U.S. Constitution
- the basic rights of citizens are protected by the U.S. Constitution
