Have the most fun you can learning Virginia and American history with Carole Marsh's "Real Kids/Real Places" Mysteries and Sets!

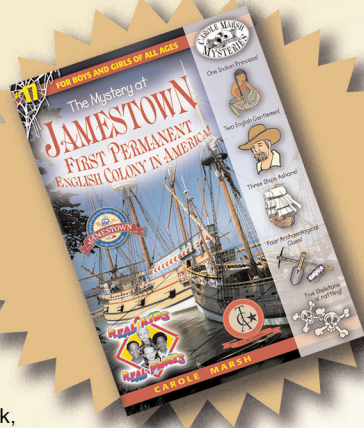
