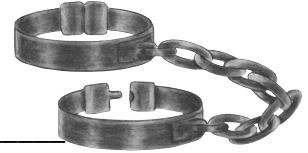


Black Achievements Through the Years!

Solve the math problems below to discover some black historical "first" years.



1. Vermont becomes first state to officially abolish slavery.

2. The first black newspaper, *Freedom's Journal*, is published for the public.

9. President George W. Bush appoints Condoleezza Rice U.S. National Security Advisor.

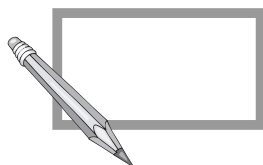
