- Even though the bridge appears to be red, it is actually painted international orange!
- Including approaches, the bridge is 1.7 miles long.

- A net suspended under the flooring of the bridge during construction saved the lives of 19 men.
- Steel used in the bridge construction came from as far away as Pennsylvania.
- Due to high winds in excess of 70 mph, the bridge has been closed three times.

• On February 22, 1985, the one billionth car crossed the bridge.

• In February 1976, the bridge appeared as a backdrop on the cover of Rolling Stone magazine.
