

# ALL-IN-ONE!

## Abraham Lincoln Middle School Teacher Instructions and Reproducible Activity

Students will research information about Abraham Lincoln and write their findings on a reproducible page featuring a drawing of a stovepipe hat.

**Supplies needed:** worksheet, reference materials, colored pencils, crayons, and dark pens for writing.

### Directions:

1. Hand out the worksheet with the stovepipe hat on it.
2. Assign each student a significant year in the life of Abraham Lincoln. Instruct students to find an important event that occurred in Abraham Lincoln's life that year. Examples include:  
1809: Lincoln born in Kentucky  
1842: Lincoln married Mary Todd  
1860: Lincoln elected president
3. Direct students to write the date and a brief explanation of it on the hat, and then lightly color the hats.
4. Display hats on the bulletin board in a timeline format.
