

ALL-IN-ONE!

Habitats, Ecosystems, and Biomes Elementary School Teacher Instructions and Reproducible Activity

This activity includes a reproducible page. Students will draw and color a picture of their own habitat.

Supplies needed: Reproducible page, markers, crayons and/or colored pencils

1. Discuss with students: Habitats are delicate environments. A habitat is the natural home of an animal or plant. Every person, plant, and animal has a habitat. Every habitat belongs to an ecosystem. In an ecosystem, plants and animals maintain a delicate balance. Biomes are giant ecosystems. Give examples of familiar habitats, ecosystems, and biomes.
2. Pass out the reproducible sheet. Explain to the students that they are to draw a picture of their own habitat on the sheet. Remind them that their habitat is their natural home. Suggest that they include themselves in the picture and lots of details.
