

ALL-IN-ONE!

Native American Middle School Teacher Instructions and Reproducible Activity

Students will create a dreamcatcher using a reproducible sheet. Students will color the pieces of the dreamcatcher and glue them together on a piece of construction paper to create their own personal dreamcatcher.

Optional Creative Writing Activity: Ask students to define a dreamcatcher and create a dream that an Indian child might have. This can be done on plain notebook paper and decorated.

Supplies needed: worksheets, textbooks, any available reference materials, colored pencils, markers, crayons, scissors, glue and tape, construction paper

1. Pass out the worksheets with pieces of a dreamcatcher on them.
2. Students will color the pieces. When finished, they cut out the individual pieces and assemble their dreamcatcher on a piece of construction paper. Glue pieces on the sheet when assembly is complete.
3. Students must indicate on the paper which tribe(s) made and used dreamcatchers.
3. Students will write their names on their creations before displaying them on the bulletin board.
