

ALL-IN-ONE!

U.S. Citizenship Elementary School Teacher Instructions and Activity

Students will choose one of the vocabulary words from the list provided for the U.S. Naturalization Test. (Vocabulary words are included in this activity.) Then, students will write their choice and the significance of that word/historical figure/holiday/place on a reproducible drawing of the Statue of Liberty.

Supplies needed: pencil, crayons or colored pencils, vocabulary list, reference material for research, reproducible drawing of Statue of Liberty

Directions:

1. Let students pick a vocabulary word from the list provided (or teacher can assign word).
2. Tell students to research the significance of their vocabulary word.
3. Pass out the reproducible sheet with the Statue of Liberty on it.
4. Direct students to write their vocabulary word and explanation inside the box by the Statue of Liberty and color their picture.
5. Ask students to present their vocabulary word to the class and then hang it on the bulletin board.
