



U.S. Citizenship

Middle School Teacher Instructions and Activity

Students will research facts about citizenship and write one fact on a reproducible sheet with a drawing of the Statue of Liberty on it. One good source for facts is the “Learn About Citizenship” heading at: <http://www.uscis.gov/portal/site/uscis>.

Supplies needed: pencil, crayons or colored pencils, reference material for research about U.S. citizenship, reproducible drawing of the Statue of Liberty

Directions:

1. Ask students to research facts about U.S. citizenship. Ask each student to choose one fact.
2. Pass out the reproducible sheet with the Statue of Liberty on it.
3. Direct students to write their fact on the reproducible sheet and color the picture.
4. Ask students to present their fact to the class and then hang it on the bulletin board.

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
