Elementary School Teacher Instructions and Activity

Students will be assigned a severe weather topic, such as a hurricane, tornado, blizzard, etc. They will research safety tips for that topic. They will write one safety tip on a reproducible sheet and decorate the sheet with pictures related to their severe weather topic.

Supplies needed: pencil, crayons or colored pencils, reference material with severe weather safety tips, reproducible page

Directions:

1. Assign students a severe weather topic, such as a hurricane, tornado, blizzard, thunderstorm, or flood.
2. Pass out the reproducible sheet.
3. Ask students to research safety tips for their topic, choose one, and write it on their sheet. After they are finished, direct them to color their sheet and decorate it with things related to their weather topic. For example: thunderbolts and raindrops for thunderstorm, etc.
4. Have students present their safety tip to the class and hang the sheet on the bulletin board.
