Where Do Germs Come From?

Remember a person, place, animal, or other host where germs can live and grow, but they do not affect the host.

Germs can be found in:

- the air
- on food, glass, and animals
- in soil and water
- on almost any surface
- on your body

Many infectious diseases live in animal hosts. These animals act as a reservoir of infection.

Germs that live on or in animals can infect other animals through:

- bites
- contaminated food, soil, or water
- blood, urine, feces, vomit, or spit that the animal

When an infectious flea, tick, fly, mosquito, or bat bite humans, they can transmit the animal disease to them. Fortunately, most animal germs do not adapt well to living in humans.

Just a few diseases humans can get from an infected animal include:

- anthrax
- brucellosis
- botulism
- rabies
- salmonella
- tetanus

An example of a "reservoir" may be a bat or a monkey that has infectious conditions and growing in them, but they do not get sick. When these reservoirs "pass" germs onto animals or to other, or to some humans, from the host to a person, it's called a zoonotic disease. These are:

This list is of only some pandemics over the years. The most deadly ones. But outbreaks and epidemics are not uncommon. In fact, they can occur almost anywhere, at any time. All do not reach the category of pandemic, which requires:

However, as people in small herds and gathering tribes shifted to more agrarian life, they began to live in larger communities. There was more opportunity for people and animals to interact. And, as there were more chances for germs to jump from animals to humans and create more epidemics.

As civilization advanced, larger cities, trade across nations and seas, and more interactions between people, animals, and environments created an almost constant gateway for germs, viruses, epidemics, outbreaks, and pandemics.

Today, we struggle with how to learn from past pandemics, implement new strategies, and respond quickly to help stop an outbreak from getting away from us.

Antibodies & Antibiotics

Antibodies are the germs of a virus or bacterium in your body that recognize the same microbes when they try to attack your body. If you have the antibodies of a disease, you are immune to it. You can get immunity by having the disease or by having germs or a vaccine against the disease.

Antibiotics are chemicals produced by one germ that kill another germ by destroying or preventing it from growing.

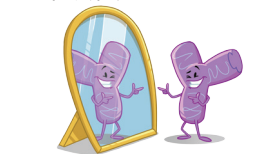
Antibiotics can occur naturally in nature. Some natural antibiotics can kill a person while killing the germs that infect them.

Antibiotics are also created in laboratories. Once tested and proven to be safe, they are produced by drug companies to be sold to doctors and hospitals.

Penicillin was the first antibiotic developed in the laboratory. It was discovered by accident in 1928.

Antibiotic Advice:

- It is important not to take antibiotics for a disease that it will not treat against.
- If you get a prescription for an antibiotic, be sure to take it all your pills—even after you feel better, the germs will flow up again and you will be sicker than ever.

The Dunlap Broadside

Broadside were single sheets of paper printed on one side, which served as public announcements or advertisements. From the first printing in 1776 until the early 1800s, broadsides were printed in public or semi-public places. They provided news of battles, deaths, coronations, and other current events. They were popular "broadsides" of their day, bringing news of current events to the public quickly—and often disappearing just as quickly.

On the sunny hot and humid morning of July 4, 1776, Congress adopted the Declaration of Independence. A hand-written copy of the Declaration was sent to the printer John Dunlap, who had already printed the first copy of the Declaration. Dunlap immediately set to work and printed the first "Dunlap Broadside." These copies were used for many years and are still used for many pages or used to sign the parchment from the original.

Today there are only 25 Dunlap Broadside that are left in the world. In 1997 a man named William H. Miller found a parchment a quarter of the size because he was interested in the "Hides in 1776" of the Declaration of Independence. This copy is now in the collection of the National Archives.

UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION
John Jay wrote "The Federalist Papers" to the "The Federalist" newspaper. If the American Republic had failed, it would have been the end of the American Republic. The "Federalist Papers" were written by Jay, Madison, and Hamilton to explain the Constitution to the people.

Key Players
Many individuals played important roles in shaping events of the American Revolution. Here are some of the key people involved and the role they had:

Benjamin Franklin – prominent member of the Continental Congress who helped frame the Declaration of Independence

George Washington – commander of the Continental Army

John Adams – main supporter of independence

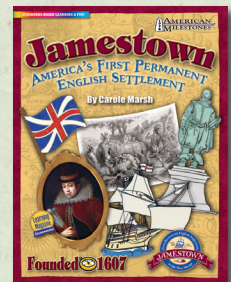
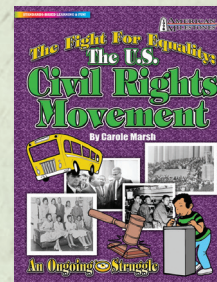
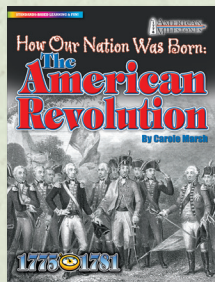
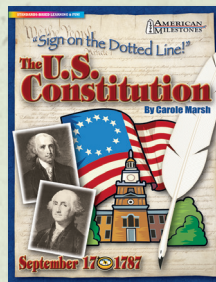
King George III – British king during the Revolutionary War

Lord Cornwallis – British general who surrendered at Yorktown

Patrick Henry – outspoken member of the House of Burgesses, inspired the patriots with his famous speech, "Give me liberty or give me death!"

Thomas Jefferson – main author of the Declaration of Independence

Thomas Paine – journalist who was the author of "Common Sense"

Chief Anderson

Pilot



Have you heard the aviation legend "fly the friendly skies"? Well, the first black man who decided he wanted to be an airline pilot found the story very uplifting. But Charles Albert "Chief" Anderson went on to earn the commercial license and train America's first black fighter pilots. He is known as the "Father of Black Aviation."

Anderson was inspired by Charles Lindbergh's flight in the Spirit of St. Louis. The very next year, 1928, he drew his first plans. At that time in history, many people did not like the idea of black pilots. Anderson had a hard time finding anyone to teach him to fly. Several people laughed at his plans, making them harder to fly.

But none of those incidents kept Anderson from pursuing his high-flying dream. Anderson finally found a man to teach him everything he needed to know to get a commercial pilot's license. In 1935, he made his first transcontinental flight.

Anderson got a job in Washington, D.C., teaching others to fly. He was then hired by the Tuskegee Institute in Alabama to serve as the chief instructor for its new program to train black pilots. He earned the nickname of "Chief." When First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt visited Tuskegee Institute's hospital, he took her on a flight. People saw a picture in the newspapers of the First Lady flying with Chief Anderson, and their views of black pilots began to change.

In 1941, the U.S. War Department formed the 98th Central Postal Directory, the first all-black fighter squadron. Soon after, "Chief" Anderson was selected to be the top flight instructor for the squadron. The 98th joined with other black squadrons to form the 332nd Central Postal Directory. They were known as the " Tuskegee Army." Because they had trained at Tuskegee Institute, one of their amazing accomplishments is that they did not lose one single bomber they escorted during World War II.

Lorraine Hansberry was a playwright who wrote *A Raisin in the Sun*. The 1959 drama is about a black family struggling to make a new and better life for themselves. The original Broadway play was produced by audiences and critics, and won many awards.

In 1961, a movie was made by the same title. The story focuses on a short period in the life of the Younger family. They receive an insurance check for \$10,000 and each person in the family has a special dream about how it should be spent.

Road to the Revolution

In the 1600s, King James I issued charters to begin Britain's colonization of the New World. These written documents allowed the establishment of colonies and the creation of colonial legislatures and courts. However, the colonies were not totally independent—they were under the rule and protection of Britain.

Britain and its colonies were very far apart, separated by the Atlantic Ocean. Messages, which had to be sent by boat, took months to get delivered. As a result, colonists developed their own independent governments and trade without much British control.

Britain spent a lot of time and money fighting against the French and Indians to protect its interest in the New World. The 1763 Treaty of Paris finally ended the war. King George III and Parliament decided the colonies should help Britain regain the money it spent in the war, so they passed several laws. Goods such as tea, sugar, and paper no longer had to be imported from Britain. They also decided that Britain needed the colonies, so Parliament passed laws that sh legislatures, appointed royal governors, and forbade settling west of the Appalachian Mountains.

Many colonists did not like this interference. British control was unfair. Organizations such as the Sons of Liberty protested against British taxation and control. "No taxation without representation" expressed one of the colonists' big demands. Tensions grew and the colonies prepared for revolution.

- Grizzly bears are great swimmers and even better runners—grizzly bears can run across land at about 35 miles per hour. That's about as fast as a horse!
- Grizzly bears eat a LOT! When preparing for winter hibernation, grizzlies can eat up to 90 pounds of food a day!
- Unlike many animals, bears see in color, just like we do.
- Talk about terrific sniffers—grizzly bears can smell food from miles away!
- Bears are hunters, but they are also grazers. Approximately 75% of what grizzly bears eat is grass, berries, roots, and other plants. The other 25% is fish, deer, elk, rodents, honey, and even insects.
- Standing upright, a grizzly can be more than 8 feet tall!
- Some grizzlies grow to weigh more than 800 pounds!
- Biologists estimate 50,000 grizzlies once lived in the United States. Today, there are only between 1,200 and 1,400 grizzlies in the United States. It is important to protect and respect these rare, wild animals.
- Grizzly bear mothers often give birth to cubs during hibernation.
- Grizzly attacks on humans are very rare, but that does not mean grizzlies are totally tame. Grizzlies are unpredictable wild animals and are best left undisturbed.
