Lesson 2: The Rise of Populism (Standard 8.1–5; 8.6a–d; 8.7a–d; 8.9c–d)

Materials Needed: Primary Source Analysis: William Jennings Bryan and the Election of 1900

#### Teacher Tips:

- To further engage students in the analysis of primary sources, provide them with magnifying glasses, if available. These can sometimes be located in Science materials!
- You may also choose to project the image digitally to allow you to zoom in on specific symbols or words

#### rou may also choose to project th

- SAY: In the last lesson we learned a lot about technology and the impact it had on American businesses. What effect do you think the rise in businesses and technology had on the agricultural industry?
  - Possible responses/ predictions may include: Perhaps farmers benefited from technology as well
    and used it to develop more efficient farming practices. More people left farming and moved to
    cities to benefit from new technologies.
- 2. SAY:
- At the turn of the century, big businesses such as Standard Oil and Carnegie Steel became extremely
  wealthy. The promise of financial gain and access to new technologies meant many people, especial
  young people, were leaving rural areas and agriculture in favor of moving to urban areas and seeking
  industry jobs. This had a significant impact on farmers.
- Explain to students that next they will learn more about these impacts and the ways that farmers responded in this period in history.

#### Student Book

Teach the content in Section 2: The Rise of Populism through a combination of teacher-led discussion and independent student work.

- Remind students to use the Evidence Collector as they read the Student Book.
- Use Internet Link: Ocala Demands and the Birth of Populism to expand instruction.
- Discuss key content and review the activities as a class.
- After students have read about the rise of populism, distribute Primary Source Analysis: William Jennings Bryan and the Election of 1900.
  - Use the Teacher Notes included to facilitate analysis and discussion.
  - You may wish to elevate the observation of the image included in Primary Source Analysis: William
    Jennings Bryan and the Election of 1900 by using one of the suggestions provided in the Teacher Tip.
