

Spin The Dreidel!

Materials: ruler, sharp pencil, construction paper, scissors, markers, tape



Directions

1. Measure and draw a five-inch square on a piece of construction paper.
2. Cut out the square.
3. Fold the points that are opposite each other toward the center of the square.
4. Use markers to print Hebrew letters on each flap.
5. Insert a pencil into the center of the folded dreidel. The point should face the ground.
6. Tape the pencil securely to the dreidel.

How To Play

- Players sit in a small circle.
- Each player places a small object (coin, chocolate gelt, nut, candy, etc.) in the center of the circle.
- Everyone takes a turn spinning the dreidel.
- When the dreidel lands on NUN, the player takes nothing from the center.
- When the dreidel lands on GIMMEL, the player takes everything that lies in the center.
- When the dreidel lands on HEY, the player takes half of what lies in the center.
- When the dreidel lands on SHIN, the player puts a game piece in the center.
- When the center is empty, all players contribute another game piece.
- Continue playing until one player has won all of the pieces.
