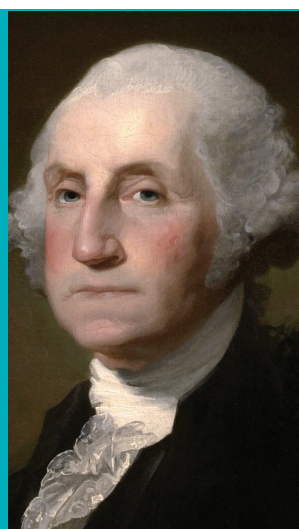

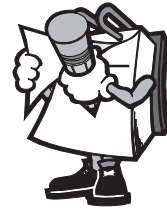

Color your state red. Color the rest of the United States yellow.**



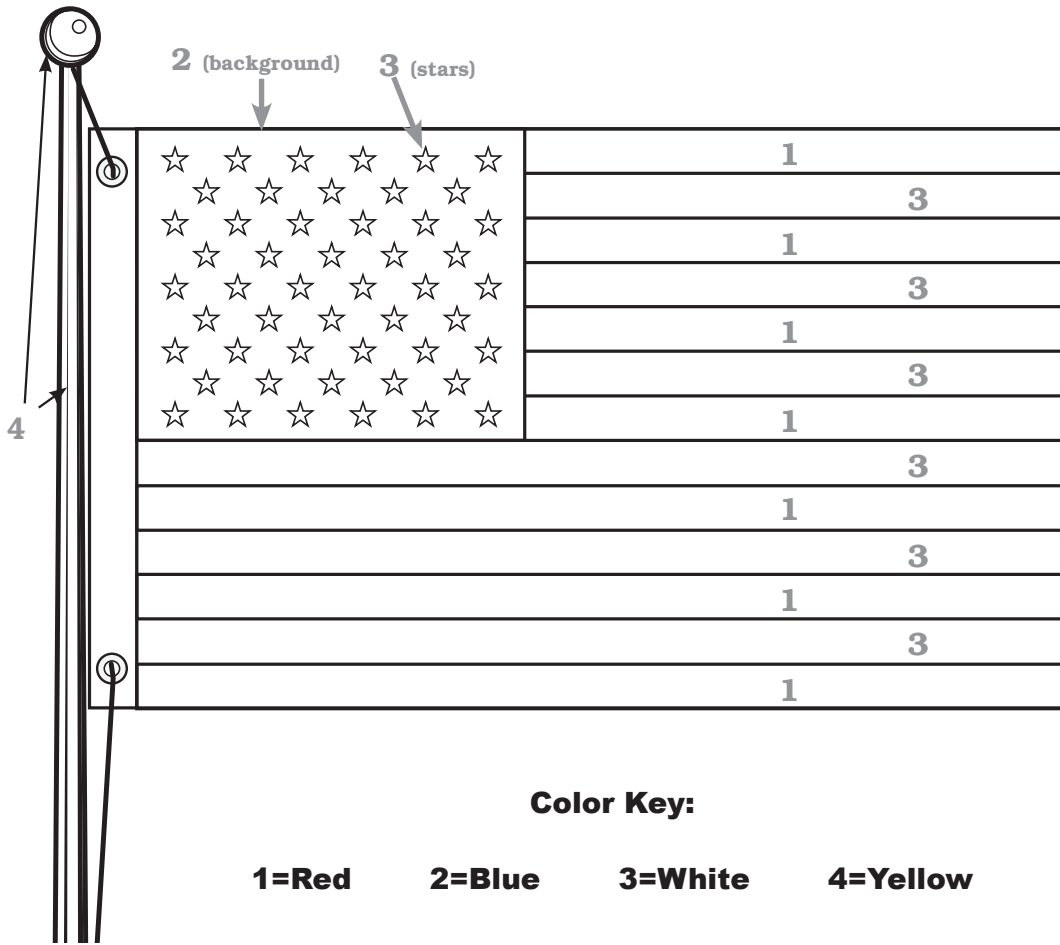
American Flag

When we display and salute the American flag, we show we are proud to be Americans!

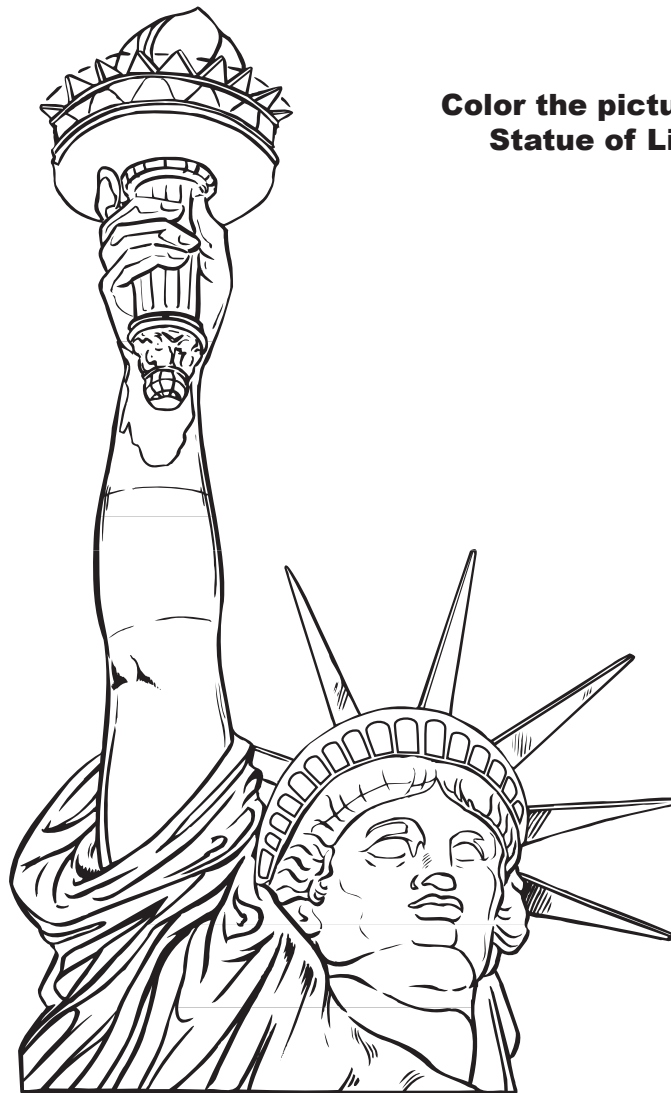
Color the flag using the color key.
