2. Write about it! Write five other possible titles for “The Mystery on the Freedom Trail.”
3. Learn about Boston! Direct book club members to choose a Boston landmark to research. Then, ask each person to present three or four facts to the class along with a picture of the landmark. Ask the group to vote on which landmark they would most like to visit.
4. Design a shirt! Runners often wear crazy and colorful shirts in the Boston Marathon. Draw your shirt design on a piece of paper, and explain what it expresses about you to the rest of the group.
